Apologies were received from Cllr. I. Brayshaw, Cllr. Mrs. P. Bugeja, Cllr. Miss J. Finch and Cllr. D. Harvey. In the absence of the Chairman the Vice-Chairman took the meeting.

2461. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

Councillors were asked to declare any pecuniary or non pecuniary interests in matters to be discussed at this meeting.

2462. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

Resolved: The minutes of the Council meetings held on 3rd February, 2015, having been circulated to members were agreed and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

2463. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Standing Orders were suspended to receive information.

Report from County Councillor Sandra Perkins

The appointment with the Police Commissioner has been confirmed for 30th March and Cllr. E. Taylor will be accompanying Mrs. Perkins. She has met with Sergeant Freaney and will be talking about Police depletion in the Wyre area.

Report from Wyre Councillor David Swift

Wyre's budget meeting is this week with the Council looking to freeze the council tax for another year. Wyre Councillor Pete Murphy introduced Shaun Burrows, prospective Conservative candidate for Brook and Catterall. Cllr. Murphy raised the s106 moneys to be spent on play facilities on Queen Elizabeth II Playing Field asking for an update and adding that further funding will be coming to Parish Councils in the New Year.

Police Report

A number of crimes were reported in the past month. During a domestic dispute an expartner has returned to take property he believed he was entitled to, an argument



escalated into an assault and the police being called. The male was arrested, the property returned and advice given to both parties. A cat flap was damaged at a house on Nightingale Way and the driver's side wing mirror on a car parked on Duckworth Drive has been damaged, whilst parked on the road outside the aggrieved address.

A female offender entered a supermarket in Garstang town centre and left without paying for alcohol, the incident was captured on CCTV and the female identified as a 57 year old from Catterall, who was dealt with, fully admitting the offence, paid compensation and was banned from entering the store again.

There were on anti-social behaviour patterns with one call regarding a neighbour dispute over a cat flap and an unwanted neighbour's cat entering the house and a group of young people causing a nuisance to other road users on Meadowcroft Avenue whilst riding a mini-motorbike and not wearing helmets.

The meeting was resumed.

2464. ASSET REGISTER AND RISK ASSESSMENTS

The expanded asset register shows the Parish Council's assets plus itemised insurance values. The risk assessments were presented and Councillors considered the asset register and risk assessments.

2465. CALL FOR SITES

Cllr. Sharples wished to raise awareness to the Councillors of what Wyre Council is looking to provide for travellers and to be alert to potential sites in both Catterall and the surrounding Parishes may impact on Catterall. The potato field was raised, although it is designated commercial land at present we must ensure it does not change in Wyre's Local Plan. There was a call for seeking allotments on the land and that grants may be available to purchase.

Resolved; To source funding for purchase of land for allotments.

The Gala Committee is seeking permission to use the Queen Elizabeth II Playing Field from Friday 29th May to Saturday 30th May to hold Catterall Gala, 2015.

Resolved: To grant permission for Catterall Gala to use the Queen Elizabeth II Playing Field on Friday 29th May and Saturday 30th May.

Councillors are invited to walk in the Gala procession through the village starting at 1.30pm from the field and take refreshments afterwards in the Village Hall.

Resolved: That approximately 8 Councillors and spouses will walk in the procession.
